

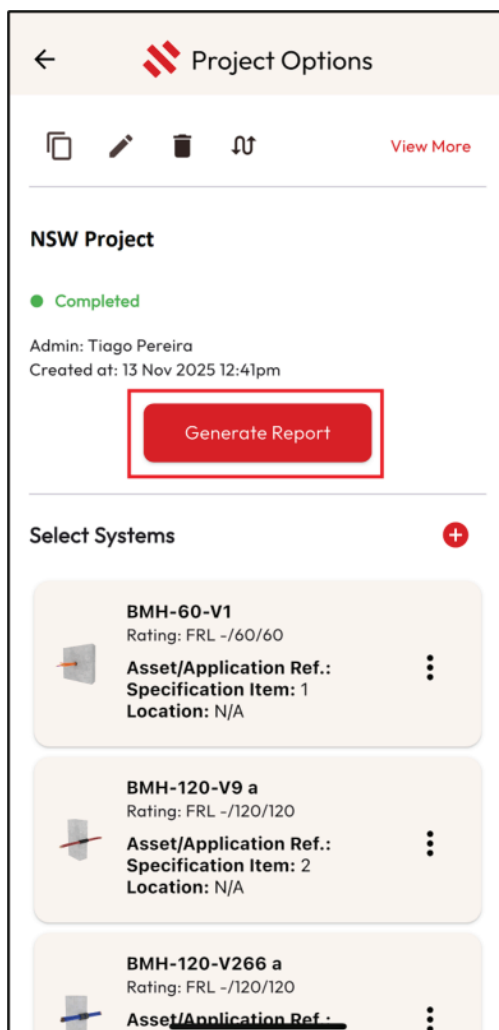

## Project Summary Report

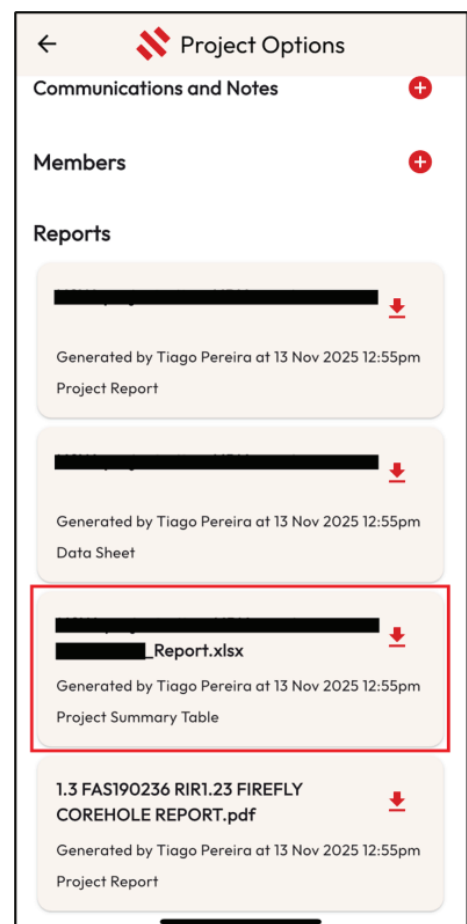

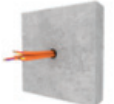
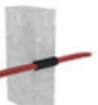
On both the mobile and desktop versions, after creating your projects and entering all relevant information for each application, simply click “Generate Report” to produce the Project Summary Report.

- On the left side, a summary of the application
- On the right side, a summary of the FIREFLY solution
- A “Notes/Observations” section where users can add comments on the applications or solutions. Notes can be added when selecting a solution for a project or later, directly on the Project Summary Report after it is generated
- Links to FIREFLY PFP for each solution, providing access to images, compliance documents, and detailed instructions

The report offers flexibility by being presented in a spreadsheet format, allowing users to add, remove, or modify information directly within the report.
